Under the present circumstances of the Covid-19 pandemic, OESO launches a new program which, like many of the previous ones, will be original, multi-disciplinary and from the outset, global:

The OESO-SEMPIRE Virtual Educational Channel

This project has been built on the strong foundation of the Platform of Excellence in Esophagology represented in the 5 parts of the world by 11 Pilot Centers (see www.oeso.org). It will use the latest virtual techniques available today.

Every month, a virtual Staff meeting will be organized by one of the Pilot Centers of the OESO-SEMPIRE Platform (*Stanford Esophageal Multidisciplinary Program in Innovative Research Excellence*).

- The meeting will be brief and it will last between one and two hours. It will be intended, in particular, for Pilot Centers located in another part of the world, taking into account the time differences.
- The meeting will start with the presentation of a challenging case in esophagology involving several disciplines. It will be followed by an exchange of views between the presenters and a discussion with those connected in other parts of the world.
- **A special commentary will be given by a renowned invited Expert thus lending his/her experience to the discussions and close the meeting.**



This new channel launched by the Platform of Excellence in Esophagology OESO-SEMPIRE will therefore offer to all members of the scientific community,

- Wherever they are in the world,
- Whatever their specialty,
- Whatever their level,

an exceptional opportunity: to attend, or participate in, a Global, Multidisciplinary Staff Meeting dedicated to a challenging clinical case of Esophagology, involving specialists from various disciplines participating from any country connected to the discussions.

Since its founding, OESO has been a global Organization going beyond borders, those of countries as well as those of disciplines, with an environment of growth particularly for its young members.

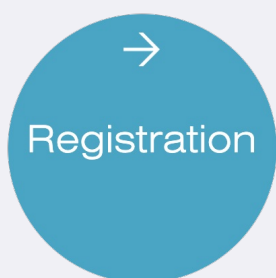
We hope you will want to take advantage of the opportunities now offered by this new initiative program of the worldwide network OESO-SEMPIRE.
